Technical Requirements

The technical requirements for the usage of GlobalX 9.0 are listed in the following sections.

1. Supported Browsers

1.1. User interface – Java script

This applies to the new Java script based-interface available with version 9.0. In general we assume a 64 bit version.

- Microsoft Edge
- Mozilla Firefox Version 57 and higher
- Google Chrome 28.0 and higher

1.2. Administrator interface

Applies to all administrative functions as well as the use of user functions with JAVA WebStart/applet. In general we assume a 64 bit version.

- Microsoft Internet Explorer 11
- Microsoft Edge Version 12 and higher
- Mozilla Firefox Version 57 and higher
- Google Chrome Version 38 and higher

(Applets only with IE 11)

Extensions of Firefox may influence the behavior of the browser (see p.e.

http://kb.mozillazine.org/Problematic_extensions)

In order to get advantage of the complete functionality of GlobalX (filetransfer in parallel threads, GlobalX container format, end to end encryption) installation of Java 1.8 is required. Files with the file name extension *.jnlp must be linked to the Java WebStart Launcher (javaws.exe).
